Microlino will enter the Swiss market by end of 2021 equipped with a 10.5 kWh BMZ battery. This will be followed by expansion into Germany, France and Italy. Variants with 6 kWh and 14 kWh will follow in the medium term. All planned Microlino variants thus fall into the light electric vehicle category L7e.

The globally active BMZ Group is working on the Microlino project across national borders. While the battery is developed and produced in Germany, BMZ China takes care of the on-board charger.
