ALEXANDER DENNIS BUSES FOR NORTH AMERICA WILL BE POWERED BY BMZ BATTERIES

Bus manufacturer Alexander Dennis, a global leader in the double-deck bus segment and a subsidiary of bus and coach mobility solutions provider NFI Group Inc., has entered into a strategic partnership with German battery manufacturer BMZ Group to support the deployment of zero-emission double-deck buses in North America, starting in 2026.



As part of the collaboration, the BMZ Group will supply battery systems for the Alexander Dennis Enviro500EV, the company's all-electric double-deck bus. Production of the batteries will take place at BMZ USA Inc. in Virginia Beach, utilizing BMZ's local manufacturing capabilities. The production volume of batteries is expected to exceed 150 megawatt-hours (MWh). The battery solution, developed by the BMZ Group's in-house research and development team, has been engineered to maximize vehicle range, battery lifespan, passenger carrying capacity and comfort – due to the efficient packaging within the low floors of the bus. This system provides a reliable and efficient energy source for high-capacity electric buses in demanding operating environments.

The partnership aligns with BMZ Group's long-term Local to Local strategy, which focuses on regional production and supply to strengthen local value chains. By manufacturing in the United States, the companies aim to reduce logistical complexity, improve sustainability performance, and contribute to the development of a resilient domestic supply infrastructure. This collaboration delivers mutual benefits for both Alexander Dennis and BMZ. It also supports broader policy goals by advancing clean transportation technologies and creating long-term economic value for the United States through localized manufacturing and innovation.
